At Ecole St. Stanislaus School, our philosophy is grounded in a restorative approach to student conduct. We believe that every situation is an opportunity for growth, learning, and the strengthening of our school community. When addressing behavior, we carefully consider each case individually, taking into account the student's age, the number of prior offenses, and the severity of the behavior. Our students recognize that we have 4 quiding principles:

Be safe, Be Kind, Be Cooperative, and Be Organized and we pride ourselves on living the teachings of Christ through our words and actions each day.

The safety and well-being of all students and school staff is our highest priority. We are committed to handling all conduct matters with compassion, fairness, and respect for the dignity of every child. Our goal is to guide students toward positive choices while maintaining a supportive and nurturing environment.

Please remember that the classroom teacher is always the first point of contact when academic or behavioral concerns arise. Our teachers work closely with students each day and are best positioned to provide insight, support, and timely communication.

#### PICK UP and DROP off

If there will be a change to your child's usual pick up, please email the classroom teacher. If your it has not been communicated to the teacher, your child will be put on the bus. Additionally, if there is not a guardian present at the time of pick up children will be put on the bus.

During morning drop off and afternoon dismissal, please do not park in front of the school as this serves as our bus lane.

A friendly reminder that the parking lot at GREENFIELD COMMUNITY LEAGUE is for the community league only and we kindly ask that you do not park in their lot. For drop off and and pickup please consider using 113th street to the east of the school.

Supervision begins at 8:15 a.m. students will not be permitted to enter the building before that time. Supervision concludes at 3:25 p.m. (12:15 on Thursdays)

#### Park After school-no supervision

Students will no longer be permitted to play in the park after dismissal without direct parental supervision. The primary purpose of after school supervision is to ensure students are picked up and get to the busses on time. In order to reduce the risk of potential injuries and missed busses, we require that parents accompany their children to the park.
