PICK UP and DROP off

For the first week, we ask parents/guardians of students in Grades 1, 2, 3, and all new students who DO NOT take the bus and are being picked up, to meet their child outside their designated entrance doors at the end of each day to help them adjust to the new routine. Doors will be marked with homeroom numbers.

During morning drop off and afternoon dismissal, please do not park in front of the school as this serves as our bus lane.

A friendly reminder that the parking lot at GREENFIELD COMMUNITY LEAGUE is for the community league only and we kindly ask that you do not park in their lot. For drop off and pickup please consider using 113th street to the east of the school.
