Personal Device Policy

1. No Use of Personal Mobile Devices During Instructional Time

Students are not permitted to use personal mobile devices (Including Smart watches) during instructional time unless directed by school staff for learning purposes. Every school also has the flexibility to extend this restriction to encompass the whole school day. **St. Stanislaus has a door to door policy from the start of the day until dismissal that personal devices are not to be used on school property.**

2. Devices Must Be Silent or Powered Off and Stored Away

If students have personal mobile device with them at school, they are required to keep the devices on silent or powered off and store them in their backpack, or another secure location.

3. No Access to Social Media

Students may not access social media on school networks or school devices. Known social media sites will continue to be blocked from Division networks.



Exceptions can be made for students who require personal mobile devices for health and specialized learning needs.

The use of cellphones, Smartwatches and tablets is not permitted at any time on school grounds at St. Stanislaus.

Student Pick Up and Drop Off

If there will be a change to your child's usual pick up, please email the classroom teacher. If your it has not been communicated to the teacher, your child will be put on the bus. Additionally, if there is not a guardian present at the time of pick up children will be put on the bus.



During morning drop off and afternoon dismissal, please do not park in front of the school as this serves as our bus lane.

A friendly reminder that the parking lot at GREENFIELD COMMUNITY LEAGUE is for the community league only and we kindly ask that you do not park in their lot. For drop off and and pickup please consider using 113th street to the east of the school.

Supervision begins at 8:15 a.m. students will not be permitted to enter the building before that time. Supervision after school concludes at 3:15 p.m. (12:15 on Thursdays)
